Dr Amit will also address various other subjects such as pocket reduction surgery and regenerative periodontal surgery using biomaterial in the treatment of single and multiple gingival recessions. He will also look into the various surgical procedures available in the treatment of peri-implantitis.

Mr TJ Nicolas will perform a hands-on demonstration on the importance of correct shade determination on both the gum and tooth and will demonstrate techniques to ensure that the right occlusion is maintained. TJ will show how to characterise restorations quickly by staining and glazing to achieve the highest aesthetic results. He will also look into Material science and their indications in relation to restoration to longevity and tissue stability (bruxism). TJ will also explain why the choice of cement is important and what its effects on the restoration are.
